Tournament Information

1. Registration (Temperature check), Player's packet

- Please finish the registration at the tournament central at least one hour before your first game.
- We will give you the player's packet at the registration.

2. Parking

- Please park your car at the designated parking area. **Please do not park your cars at the prohibited area. Also, street parking is not allowed.**
- When parking, please print out the [parking permit](#) permit and put it on the dashboard. You can't park your cars at the tournament without the parking permit.
- The tournament organizing committee are not responsible for any accidents or other incidents that may occur during the tournament.
- Please note your car may get damaged (for example, by a baseball).

3. Trainer

- We have a nurse and three sports trainers at the medical tent. Also, there is an AED.
- Sports trainers give you first-aid for injuries. They also tape up and practice acupuncture for your best performance. If you get taped up, please bring a tape unless unexpected injuries. Please note you have to pay **500JPY** if you don't bring a tape.
- Ice is not provided except for emergencies. Please bring your own ice for icing and drinks.

4. Injuries and Insurance

- Depending on the injuries, we will refer you to a hospital or call an ambulance. If you go to a hospital, please bring an insurance card with you.
- All players are covered by sport insurance. If you are injured and decide to go to a hospital, please be sure to report to the tournament organizing committee, receive an insurance report form, fill it out, and submit it. Please note that without this procedure, we will not be able to contact the insurance company, and your injury will not be covered by the insurance, even if it occurred during the tournament.
- The tournament organizing committee are not responsible for any accidents or other incidents that may occur during the tournament.
